**PROGRAM INFORMATION**

This program is a one-time mandatory amnesty program for vehicle code and non-vehicle code infraction cases. Misdemeanor violations and/or cases with misdemeanor convictions are not eligible for amnesty in Santa Cruz County. Misdemeanor violations and/or cases with misdemeanor convictions are also not eligible for driver's license restoration.

***Are you eligible for amnesty?***

If, after this application is submitted, the court or county discovers you are not eligible for amnesty because you have one or more outstanding misdemeanor or felony warrants or owe victim restitution in this county, you will be notified that your application is being suspended. Once you have resolved any issues with warrants and/or outstanding victim restitution, you may contact the court's collections agency (Alliance One) to request that your application be returned to active status and processed accordingly.
